# **Types of Roles**

We offer a range of apprenticeship roles, catering to both entry-level candidates and those with prior experience and qualifications. Examples of the roles we will have on this project include, but are not limited to:

### **Entry-Level Roles**

#### 1. Groundworker

- Involves basic construction tasks such as site preparation, excavation, and groundwork.
- No prior experience required.

## 2. Site Administration

- Entails managing site documents, assisting with project coordination, and maintaining communication between teams.
- No prior experience required.

### 3. Junior Engineer

- Supports senior engineers in planning, designing, and overseeing construction projects.
- o No prior experience required but is preferred.

### **Experienced Roles**

## 1. Electrician

- Requires prior experience and a Level 2 qualification in electrical installation.
- o Involves installation, maintenance, and repair of electrical systems.

#### 2. Plumber

- o Requires prior experience and a Level 2 qualification in plumbing.
- Includes installing, maintaining, and repairing plumbing systems.

### 3. Carpenter

- o Requires prior experience and a Level 2 qualification in carpentry.
- Involves constructing, installing, and repairing structures and fixtures made from wood and other materials.

### **Application Process**

## **Entry-Level Roles**

Eligibility: Open to all candidates, no previous experience required.

- **Duration:** Minimum of 6 months.
- How to Apply: Submit a CV highlighting any relevant skills or interests.

## **Experienced Roles**

- **Eligibility:** Applicants must possess a Level 2 qualification in the relevant trade and ideally have some construction experience.
- **Duration:** Minimum of 6 months.
- How to Apply: Submit a CV detailing previous experience and qualifications.
