Dear Residents,

Re: Ground Investigation Works at Ham Close

We are writing to inform you that ground investigation works will be taking place at Ham Close from **Monday 3rd November**. These works are expected to last up to 3 weeks and are part of the preparation for phases 2 and 3 of the redevelopment.

The investigations will involve excavating trial holes at four locations across the site, which are marked on the image below for your reference. This work is essential to assess ground conditions and support the planning of the next stages of construction.

For safety reasons, exclusion zones will be established on the grassed areas. We kindly ask that children be reminded to avoid these zones while the work is taking place.

Once the investigations are complete, the trial holes will be backfilled, and the affected areas will be re-turfed to restore the sites.

We will make every effort to minimise disruption, and all works will be carried out in line with health and safety regulations.
